





To mark the centenary of the Pirate Park in Cliff Drive next year, Canford Cliffs Land Society is proposing to fund an upgrade to the facilities in the Pirate Park, as the current facilities have served the community well but are beginning to show the effects of usage, time and weather. stamps for **The Bible Society**. There is a box in the church porch where you can leave them but please **do not** put other items into the stamps collection box.




Teddies Baby and Toddler Group Every Monday (term-time) between 2pm and 3.30pm
