Please Bring Gloves/Hedge Trimmers (self-powered)/
Kneelers/Loppers/Rakes/
Secateurs/Trowel and Fork/Empty Compost/Bin Bags

Tasks

Empty composters into bin bags. Cover the tops of the hedgehog houses. Take the compost home to use, or stack into the yellow bag near the office so others can take and use it. **Re-build the composters.**

Cut up the tree trunk between the Bury Memorial and the boundary fence.

Dig out brambles, holly and other saplings between and on the graves, bag them and, if possible, take them home to your green bin.

Gather branches and twigs and build log piles at the boundary.

Pull up ivy from the gravestones.

Rake and weed the uncared for graves.

Shape the shrubs on the graves.

Tidy up - move vases back to an appropriate grave, **litter and old wreaths** to the bin.

Come along for this quiet time to pray for our church, our community, and the wider world.

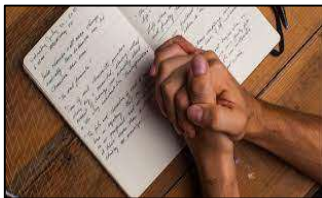
