Archbishop of Canterbury Mission to the Diocese of Salisbury

A diocesan wide mission weekend is to take place from 9th to 11th June with the Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby.

Archbishop Justin is coming to meet with young people, students, volunteers and communities to share the good news of Jesus' love.

Rhythm of Prayer

Every church in the diocese has a part to play: we are all invited to take part in a 'Rhythm of Prayer' in preparation for this time of intentional evangelism. It is really important that the whole diocese unites in prayer, asking God to be at work before, during and after this really special weekend. There will be opportunities to pray during the weekend itself. Do make use of these daily prayers (link coming soon), put together by Rev'd Nigel Done (Diocesan Director of Ordinands) and Rev'd Tony Monds (Bishop's Chaplain) in your personal prayers as well as in Sunday worship.

Events

A small team of evangelists will spread out across the diocese to share their own stories of faith and transformation. They will lead services and training events around the diocese in support of the Archbishop's mission and joining with the diocese in reaching out to make Jesus Christ known.

Archbishop Justin will visit schools, an army base, a prison, join in a young people's event and spend time with the Gypsy and Traveller community during the weekend. The mission will culminate in a celebration event in Salisbury Cathedral Close on the afternoon of 11th June. All are welcome to join in person or via YouTube live stream. Please do invite guests to this event who may be interested in hearing a message about faith in Jesus Christ

Poole Foodbank
