- **Live streaming and your privacy.** Since the 10:30am service will be broadcast publicly online via YouTube, we are mindful of the importance of your privacy. There will be one camera, located at the very back of Church, which will focus on the front of Church and on the people leading worship there. However, there is the possibility of fleetingly being ‘caught on camera’ so please only come if you are comfortable with this possibility. You can reduce this possibility by sitting at the rear of Church.
- **Covid guidelines.** Please stay at home if you feel unwell. Come with a **mask** or other face covering, though children are exempt (in similar fashion to school policy). Masks should always be worn inside the Church. Please use the **sanitiser** as you enter and leave the Church. Please keep to **social distancing** and be prepared to sit where you are asked by our stewards. Although a small group may sing in worship, sadly, there is **no congregational singing** in Church. Please leave the Church promptly after the service keeping the **aisles and exit areas unobstructed**. Our risk assessment is available upon request.
