Please let the office know straight away – we want to hear from you.



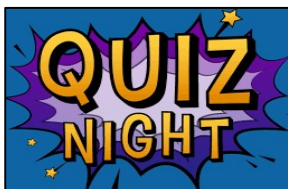
Quiz Night

Play-and-Pray-Date at the Pirate Park

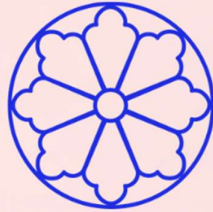
Where: Canford Cliffs Pirate Ship Play Park

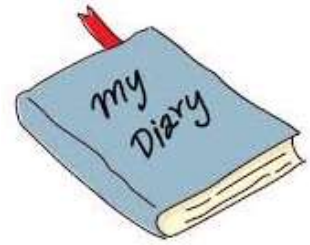

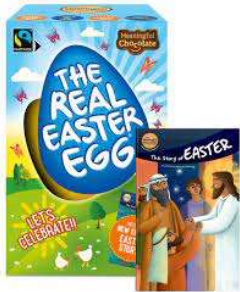

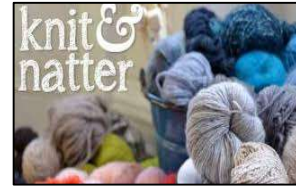
