Pension Credits

Check you are eligible for Pension Credit:

The Winter Fuel Payment is an annual payment to help you with heating costs during the colder months. The Government announced in July 2024 that, from this year onwards, to be eligible you must have reached State Pension age and also receive a qualifying means-tested benefit e.g. pension credit, universal credit or income support.



The last possible date to make a successful backdated claim to receive the Winter Fuel Payment is 21st December. Applications for Pension Credit can be made on the **How to Claim** page on GOV.UK or over the phone by calling 0800 99 1234 (Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm).

To mark the centenary of the Pirate Park in Cliff Drive next year, Canford Cliffs Land Society is proposing to fund an upgrade to the facilities in the Pirate Park, as the current facilities have served the community well but are beginning to show the effects of usage, time and weather. The proposal is for a contribution by the Society to be matched by funding provided by BCP Council from the Community Infrastructure Fund.
